Annual report for Bergen Scottish Society 2024

About the society

The Bergen Scottish Society is a non-profit organisation founded on the 28th of April 2005. It is officially registered at the Brønnøysund Register Centre, with the organisation number 988 639 958.

The aim of the society is to promote and celebrate Scottish culture. It based in Bergen and is open to all those who would like to take part in music, dance, literature and other activities which are long standing traditions in Scotland.

The society aims to attract ex-patriates from Scotland, Norwegians who have lived in or travelled to Scotland and anyone else who love Scotlish traditions.

The committee

The society is run by a committee elected by members at the society's annual general meeting each year. The committee in 2024 comprised:

Treasurer: Michal Gosiewski, elected 2024

Secretary: Hannah Petrie, elected 2024

Information coordinator: Willie Dawson, elected 2023

Keeper of the tartan: Jim Fulton, elected 2024

The committee held five meetings in 2024 and dealt with the society's budget and accounts, membership, activities and future plans.

Membership

The society had 65 members in 2024, of which 6 were honorary life members. This was an increase of 3 members compared to 2023. Jim Fulton became the sixth honorary members at the AGM in 2024 for his services to haggis production and distribution. The Burns Supper has traditionally proved to be the biggest single event for recruiting new members and renewing memberships. The committee also sent out membership reminders to the members that had provided email addresses and the vast majority renewed their memberships. The society did not hold email addresses for all members from 2023, as many had joined via VIPPS and not given an email address. As a result, these people were not contacted and asked to renew their membership. The membership renewal email was a success and illustrates how important it is to collect contact information for members, something that can be challenging when membership is sold together with Burns Supper tickets via Vipps.

In addition to organising social events, the Society arranged haggis production and distribution, together with Solheim Kjøtt, and sold a number of ties, scarves and sashes in the Bergen Scottish tartan.

Other activities

The leader of the Society was interviewed live on air on NRK Vestland on Monday 4th March in connection the screening of Martin Compston's Norwegian Fling on NRK TV the same day. Bergen Scottish Society and Bergen Pipes and Drums featured in the second episode in the series, raising awareness of the Society and leading to a number of orders for scarves and ties.

Finances

The Society made a surplus of kr. 25, 462 in 2024, including bank interest. It took in kr. 142,736 in revenues from membership fees, events, haggis sales and pipe band activities and paid out kr. 117,353 in expenses. The society's total assets increased from kr. 130,812 in 2023 to kr. 156,273 in 2024. These are held in the form of cash in the bank.

Haggis sales provided a healthy income for the society once again, more than offsetting the costs of bringing a band over from Scotland for the Autumn ceilidh.

Bergen Pipes and Drums made a loss of kr. 3,012 in 2024. The band generated income of kr. 11,100 against expenses of kr. 13,112. All gig payments went straight out again to those involved and no membership fees were collected to cover any sundry costs.

Continuing operations

No significant changes have occurred since the end of the financial year that affect the accompanying annual accounts or the continued operation of the society. The committee confirms that the continued operation of the society was assumed when preparing the annual accounts.
